

**TENNESSEE UNINSURED MOTORIST

Section 56-7-1201 of the Tennessee Insurance Code requires that every motor vehicle liability policy delivered, issued for delivery, or renewed in this state shall include uninsured motorists coverage covering bodily injury and property damage liability. The insured shall have the right to reject this coverage in whole or in part. If coverage is desired, coverage shall be in limits of no more than the bodily injury and property damage policy limits, and no less than Tennessee Financial Responsibility Limits.

*Uninsured Motorists Property Damage losses are subject to a \$200.00 deductible. This deductible does not apply when Collision Coverage is afforded by the same company and when the operator of the other vehicle has been positively identified and is solely at fault.

Please note:

This document signed by the named insured or legal representative which initially rejects such coverage or selects lower limits shall be binding upon every insured to whom such policy applies and shall be conclusively presumed to become a part of the policy or contract when issued or delivered, irrespective of whether physically attached thereto. Unless the named insured subsequently, requests such coverage in writing, the rejected coverage need not be included in or supplemental to any continuation, renewal, reinstatement, or replacement of such policy, or the transfer of vehicles insured thereunder, where the named insured had rejected the coverage in connection with a policy previously issued by the same insurer; provided, that whenever a new application is submitted in connection with any renewal, reinstatement or replacement transaction, the provisions of this section shall apply in the same manner as when a new policy is being issued.
